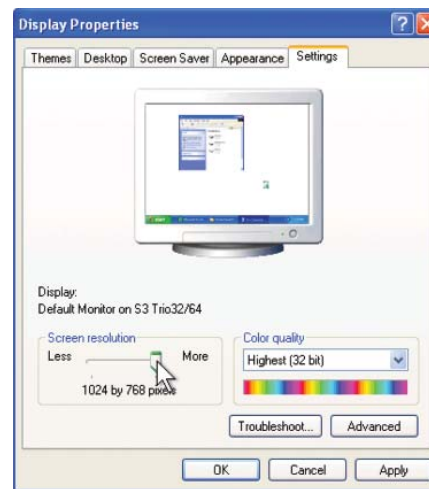
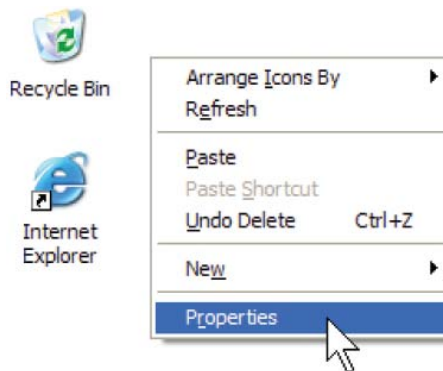


Adjusting Monitor Resolution

If the program doesn't appear to "fit" on your screen, you probably need to change your screen resolution. This software title requires a minimum resolution of 1024x768 pixels. If you have an older computer, it may be set to only display 800x600 pixels. Follow these steps to change your monitor's resolution.

1. Close any programs that are running.
2. Right-click the desktop (any open area on your computer screen).
3. Click **Properties**.
4. The Display Properties dialog box will open. Click the **Settings** tab.
5. Drag the Screen resolution slider to the right to select 1024 by 768 pixels.
6. Click **Apply** and follow the instructions or **OK** to make the change.



Notes: If you have an older monitor, it may not be capable of displaying 1024x768. If that is the case, you will not be able to run this program. Also, making screen resolution changes often results in your monitor's screen not being completely "filled." You may need to make adjustments to your monitor using its buttons and controls to stretch and reposition the screen image.
